
New View & Widget "My Approval Forecast" on project level

Revise full-text index logic



In one of the last releases, we updated the full-text indexing logic to enable "snowball" searching for body / remark fields. This often resulted in users not receiving the expected results when searching.

Based on that we decided to change the existing logic again.

Example: Save a correspondence with the word "claims" in the body

Implementation of TinyMCE to improve usability and enable rich text formatting.

We've decided to keep this as simple as possible for now and only provide a few key formatting options.

In addition, we have introduced a new bottom navigator for easier navigation in event edit mode
